Sunday, September 9th, was a day of empowerment for young females aged 8 - 18 and it was all done through sports and amazing female role models!

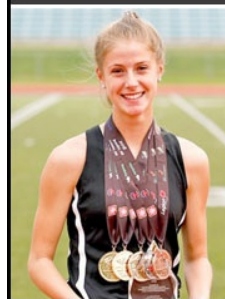


