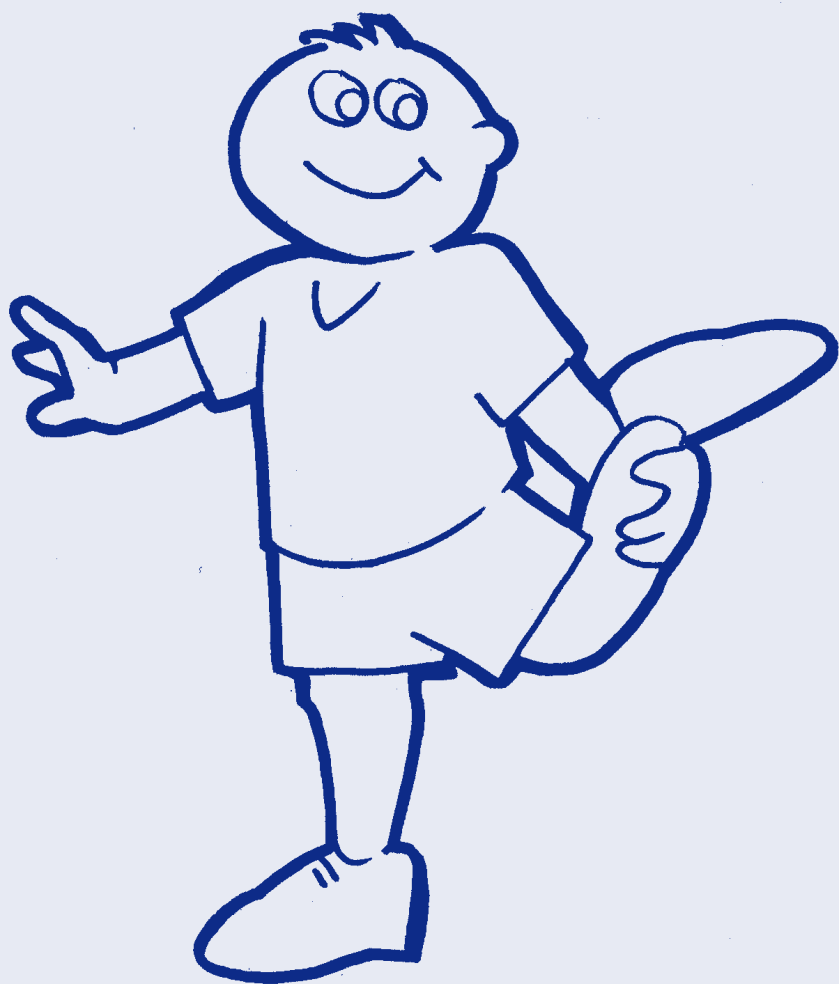
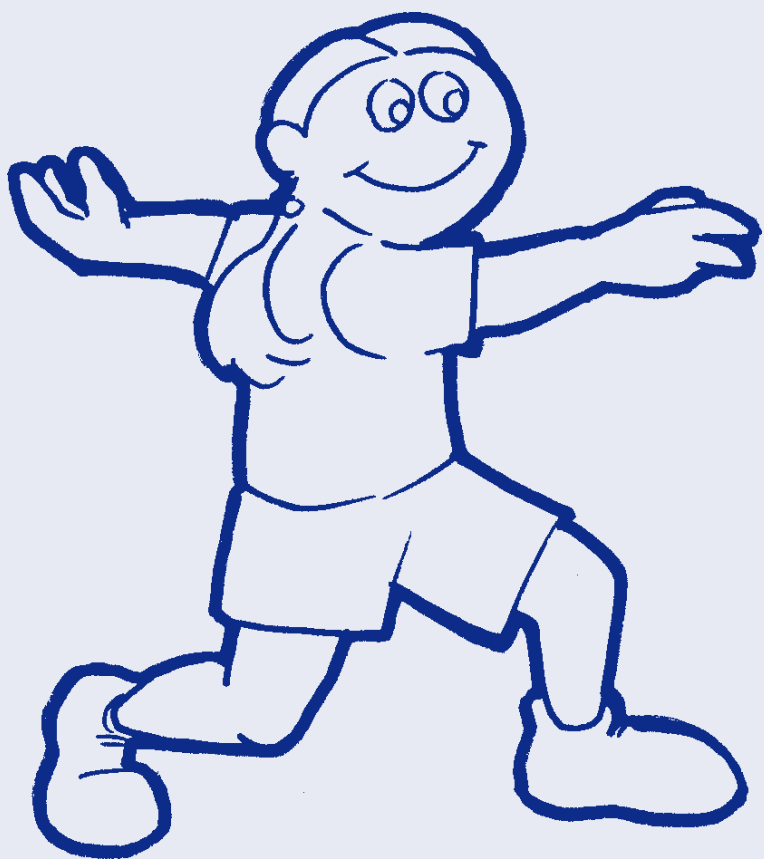


WHY DO CHILDREN PLAY SPORTS?
