Under the guidance of Team Saskatchewan and the Aboriginal Excellence program each Sport Coordinator will work to provide skill development opportunities for Aboriginal athletes and to prepare Team Sask for the 2011 North American Indigenous Games.

The Sport Coordinator's duties will include;

- Hosting a required amount of skill development camps for Aboriginal athletes 12 to 16 years of age throughout the province.
- Hosting talent id camps for a specified sport of Team Sask.
- Providing training and competition opportunities for a specified sport of Team Sask.
- Providing Sport Medicine & Science opportunities for a specified sport of Team Sask.
- Providing other essential services necessary in performing the previously mentioned duties.
- Administrative duties such as scheduling, data collection, and activity reports as required.
- Weekend and evening work will be required.
- Travel to attend and coordinate camps will be required.

The time commitment required by Sport Coordinator(s) will be extensive through out the process and should be taken into consideration when applying.
